

Environment Chairperson

The district environment chairperson encourages clubs in the district to develop Lions Green Team projects such as: cleaning the environment, planting trees, recycling and environmental education. The chairperson is also responsible for encouraging clubs to participate in the Lions Environmental Photo Contest.

Chairperson Duties

- Become familiar with the Information for Chairpersons section on the association's Web site
- Identify appropriate Lions Green Team projects for the district
- Meet with Lion leaders to develop a coordinated Lions Green Team plan for the year
- Encourage clubs to participate in the annual Lions Environmental Photo Contest. Ensure that the selected district photo is submitted to the council chairperson by January 15.
- Visit clubs. Explain the importance of protecting our natural resources. Encourage clubs to appoint an environment chairperson. Discuss the urgency of protecting our natural resources, and solicit feedback and suggestions. Work as a team to develop an outline for your year as chairperson.
- Keep the governor and the international office informed of district activities. Provide a summary report to your successor.
